REALITY #4. YOU NEED TO YOURSELF OF WHO YOU ARE IN CHRIST JESUS.

Galatians 2:20 I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

- We believe God because His evidences are overwhelming. (Romans 1:19-20)
- God created you. (Genesis 1:26, Psalm 139:13-16, Colossians 1:16)
- Preach yourself the gospel: saved by grace, righteousness of Christ. (Ephesians 2:8-9)
- You are here on earth to bring Glory to God through your life. (Ephesians 2:10)
- You know right from wrong because you are a moral being—you have the Holy Spirit in you. (Ephesians 1:14, Matthew 22:37-39, Romans 2:14-15)
- You have eternal life in Christ Jesus. (John 3:16)

REALITY #5. GOD WANTS YOU TO ADDRESS THE WITH GRACE AND TRUTH.
